REVISED Proposal D57 School Start/Dismissal Times 2010-2011

The District 57 Board of Education is currently discussing an administrative proposal that would relocate first grade to Westbrook School beginning next year, 2010-2011. One result of relocating first grade would be the necessity to alter each of our school's start and dismissal times. Unfortunately, limitation on the number of buses in our fleet prohibits us from keeping our current start/dismissal times and purchasing more buses is cost prohibitive (approximately \$160,000 annually).

The original recommendation for start/dismissal times for 2010-2011 presented in the Configuration Study Executive Summary and 1-page report located on the on the District 57 Web site (www.d57.org) has been **revised**.

The **REVISED** proposal for 2010-2011 start/dismissal times are as follows:

- Lincoln Middle School start 7:45am – dismissal 2:49pm
- Fairview/Lions Park start 8:50am – dismissal 3:20pm
- Westbrook first grade start 9:20am – dismissal 3:50pm
- Westbrook PreK-K morning start 9:20am – dismissal 11:50am
- Westbrook PreK-K afternoon start 1:20pm – dismissal 3:50pm

The following table also includes transportation route start/end times. The italicized print underneath the proposed times indicates current (2009-2010) times.
