## **CASCADE MOUNTAIN**

What: A Sunday day/night ski trip to Cascade Mountain Portage, WI

When: Sunday, February 14<sup>th</sup> 7:30 a.m. - 11:30 p.m.  
(No school on Monday, February 15<sup>th</sup>)

Who: Open to Lincoln Ski Club members only

Cost: \$95 - includes transportation, equipment rental, beginner ski lesson, lift ticket, and Subway lunch (\$24 discount if own equipment) **\*\* If trip is cancelled for any reason, refund will only be given for equipment rental, lift ticket, and lunch. Bus charges incurred will be deducted before a refund is issued.**

Sign Up: Complete and return form with full payment to the Lincoln School office **no later than February 5<sup>th</sup>**. Make check payable to Lincoln Middle School Ski Club.

**\*\* PLEASE NOTE - Cost for the trip is based on full buses. Although the sign-up deadline is February 5<sup>th</sup>, participation for the trip will be made on a first come first serve basis.**

All children **MUST** ride the bus to/from Cascade. No one can be dropped off/picked up at Cascade.

# Day of the Trip Information

1. Bring all your clothes, equipment etc. to school the morning of the trip. Have all belongings together in a duffle bag clearly labeled with first and last name.
2. Drop off- The morning of the trip; please drop your child off in the back of Lincoln near the bus turnaround. We will meet in the school cafeteria however only the rear door will be open.
3. Pick up- Please pick up your child in the front of Lincoln. The buses will pull into the front turnaround; please do not park in the turnaround. The school will not be open when we return; your prompt pick up will be greatly appreciated.
4. Food- We will provide a Subway 6" sandwich, chips and water bottle for lunch at Cascade. It is recommended that the children bring a sack dinner and extra snacks. Food may be purchased at the resort, however the food lines can be long and it is expensive.
5. Clothes- Dress for the cold!! It is best to dress in layers. The children can always take off a layer should they feel warm. Please be sure your child brings snow pants, a hat, scarf or face protection and good warm ski gloves/mittens. Cheap gloves/mittens = Frozen fingers

# Cascade Ski Trip Information

1. The cost of the ski trip is \$95 which includes bus transportation, day/night lift ticket, beginner ski lesson, equipment rental (skis, poles, boots) from Cascade Ski Resort and a Subway 6" sandwich lunch. (\$24 discount if own equipment)
2. **All charges incurred will be deducted from the total before a refund is issued.**
3. The bus will leave Lincoln as close to 7:30 a.m. as possible and will return at approximately 11:30 p.m. Parents are expected to pick up their children at Lincoln on time. The school will be closed when we return. The children will be dropped off at the front of the school.
4. All children **MUST** ride the bus to/from Lincoln on the bus. **NO** child will be allowed to meet us at Cascade or be picked up from Cascade.
5. All children at the beginner level will be required to take a lesson.
6. Snowboarding Rules - Snowboarding is very popular. It is also very difficult. No beginner skiers will be allowed to snowboard. Snowboarders will only be allowed at the intermediate level. All snowboarders must wear a helmet.
7. The children will be required to check in with a chaperone twice in the lodge during the trip. Attendance will be taken before leaving Lincoln and Cascade Mountain.
8. Students will forfeit their lift ticket for any of the following: **unsafe behavior, foul language, reckless skiing, bus misconduct, skipping a lesson, abuse of rental equipment or insubordination to a chaperone.**
