Children must be five years-old by September 1, 2010, to enroll in kindergarten for the 2010/2011 school year. The new hours for our AM session will be 9:20 a.m. to 11:50 a.m. and our PM session will begin at 1:20 p.m. to 3:50 p.m. All District 57 kindergarten students attend Westbrook School, 103 South Busse Road. Parents will also have the opportunity to get information for programming and Transportation.

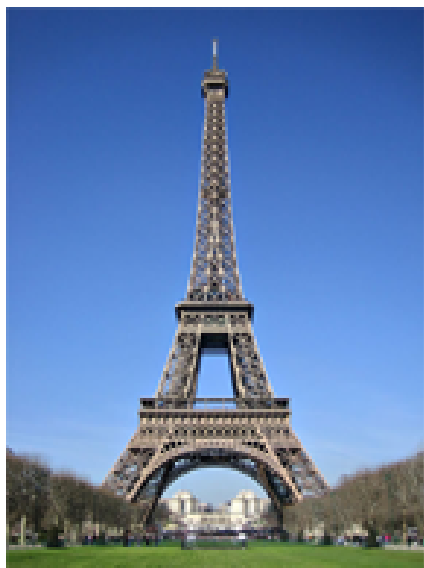

IT'S IN OUR HANDS

In March 2010, Census questionnaires will be delivered to every Mount Prospect resident. Everyone should know that the 2010 Census is Easy, Important, and Safe.

Easy: In just 10 minutes, you can make a difference. One of the shortest census forms in history, the 2010 Census form asks 10 questions and takes about 10 minutes to complete.

Important: The 2010 Census is a historic event that will help shape our nation's future for the next 10 years. With accurate census data, we can create a portrait of our nation's growing population and determine what's needed to better provide for everyone.

Safe: By law, the Census Bureau cannot share your answers with anyone, including other federal agencies and law enforcement entities. All Census Bureau employees take an oath of nondisclosure and are sworn for life to protect the confidentiality of the data. The penalty for unlawful disclosure is a fine of up to \$250,000 or imprisonment of up to five years, or both.

Completing the 2010 Census form will shape the future for you, your community and the country.
